We are changing our focus in Literacy. We have moved from Fairy Tales to a series of books called *The Magic Tree House* series. In each book, the title characters Jack and Annie, travel to a different place and time. We will spend the first week of the theme building background knowledge about the time period and culture Jack and Annie will visit in the story. Week 2-3 of the theme will be spent covering one chapter of the story each day. Children will read and write about Jack and Annie and learn Science and Social studies concepts related to the geographic location and time period the books takes place in. Children will also use the background knowledge and story events they learn about to dramatize the story in centers.

### Spotlight Activity: Story lab with Chapter books

Chapter books are used in Kindergarten increase the complexity of play and encourage play that continues and evolves over time. The Magic Tree House series was chosen because of the interesting storylines, complex plots and ties to nonfiction topics.
